→ Submit your topic and become a host for a session by completing **the call for proposal form**.

**UNH team provides support** adjusted to host's needs: promotion, registration and communication with participants, technical support during the session etc.  
→ **pre-session** coordination meeting 1-2 prior to the session to discuss the final agenda, UNH support etc.

## How does it work?

- Every third Tuesday of the month at 1 p.m. CET (Oct. - June)
- Sessions up-to-1-hour-long

### Set up of sessions:

- Introduction: Welcome, brief overview of Unite! and Networking Hub, introduction of host (lead by UNH team)
- Main discussion: insight into the topic, sharing experience and good practices (facilitated by host)
- Wrap-up by UNH team with a short feedback survey to gather insights from participants

## After the session

UNH team provides a follow-up email to all participants and the host , including:

- Short summary, presentation and other materials shared by the host
- Contact details of session participants
- Encouragement to continue building relationships using the tools and resources available within Unite!: Seed Fund, staff weeks, etc.
